



AWARD CONDITIONS - 2024

Surveying Honours Year Scholarship

Value

The scholarship will have a maximum value of \$8000 to be paid in two instalments.

Eligibility

Recipient must:

- be a domestic student currently residing in Australia
- have graduated within the last 5 years with a Bachelor of Spatial Science Technology (Surveying)
- be intending to commence their (Honours) year and enrol full-time at UniSQ in the Bachelor of Surveying (Honours) in Trimester 1 2024.

Conditions

- The duration of the scholarship is for 1 year.
- The scholarship will be forfeited if the recipient:
 - fails to continue to meet the eligibility criteria for the duration of the scholarship
 - changes their program outside of the Bachelor of Surveying (Honours)
 - does not enrol in a minimum of 6 study units across the 2024 academic year, as follows:
 - minimum 3 study units in Trimester 1; and
 - minimum 3 study units across Trimesters 2 and 3
 - defers their program of study
 - withdraws from study at UniSQ
 - fails to maintain a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 4.0.
- UniSQ reserves the right to alter the conditions of the scholarship.

Payment

- Payments are made approximately 4 weeks after the first census date in Trimester 1 and Trimester 2.
- Payment will be credited to the recipient's bank account in two instalment, as follows:
 - \$4000 - Trimester 1
 - \$4000 - Trimester 2
- Payment of the subsequent instalment will be subject to satisfactory progress in the recipient's study program. In the event the recipient does not continue to meet the scholarship's eligibility criteria and conditions, they may be required to show cause why the scholarship should not be cancelled.
